

KFF Summer Solstice Rules

The KFF Summer Solstice event encourages Activators and Hunters to take advantage of the extended daylight and warm weather to operate during the evening hours. The KFF Marathon Challenge wants to continuously draw attention to the importance of protecting nature, flora and fauna. And to encourage hams to *Make Nature Your Shack*.

GENERAL RULES: Operators are required to follow rules of their countries, within restrictions of their licenses, and to follow rules set forth by WWFF and its national organizations.

ACTIVITY PERIOD: From 2200-0400z from the first day of summer in June through the last day of summer in September.

ELIGIBILITY: The Summer Solstice event is open to all WWFF Hunters worldwide and to all Activators operating from KFF References.

BANDS: All Amateur bands, including HF, VHF, and UHF (Note: Repeater QSOs are not permitted consistent with WWFF Rules.)

MODES: All modes are permitted. Endorsement stickers are offered for single mode achievements for CW, SSB, and Data.

PARTICIPATION CERTIFICATES: A special participation certificate will be available for all Hunters working at least 14 different KFF References and to Activators with successful activations (44 QSOs) from at least 7 different KFF References. And as is normally permitted, multiple visits can be made to reach 44 QSOs for a successful activation. Endorsement stickers will be available for both Hunters and Activators for each additional 7 KFF References worked or activated.
