

# KFF Band Hopper's Honor Roll Request Instructions

The Band Hopper's Honor Roll award must be requested through a process outside of the normal WWFF Logsearch award requesting process. Hunter's, however, can use Logsearch to determine their eligibility and to track their progress.

Request for the initial award, and subsequent sticker endorsements, should be sent to [n9mm@arrl.net](mailto:n9mm@arrl.net) and include the following information:

- Name and callsign
- List of qualifying bands and number of KFF references worked on each band

Step-by-step process using Logsearch:

1. Log into [wwff.co](http://wwff.co), select Logsearch from menu, then Search Logs using your callsign. You will arrive at this screen.

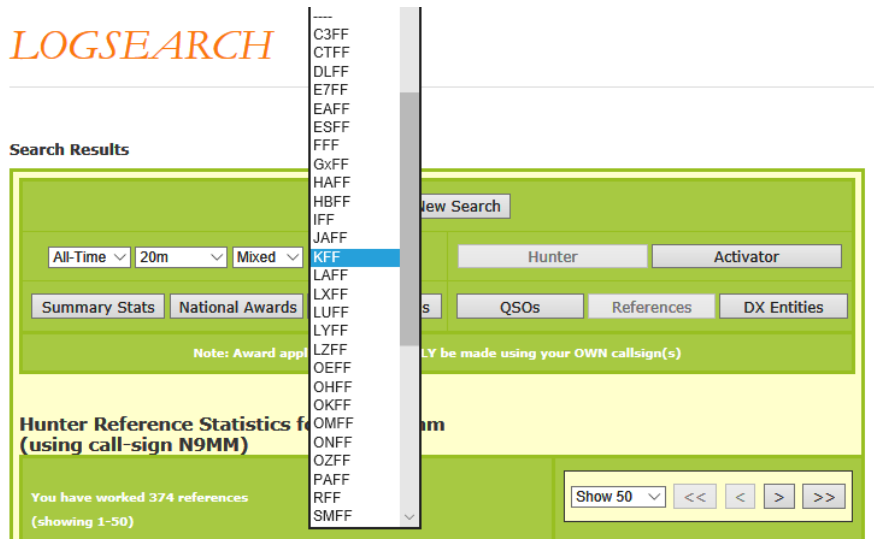

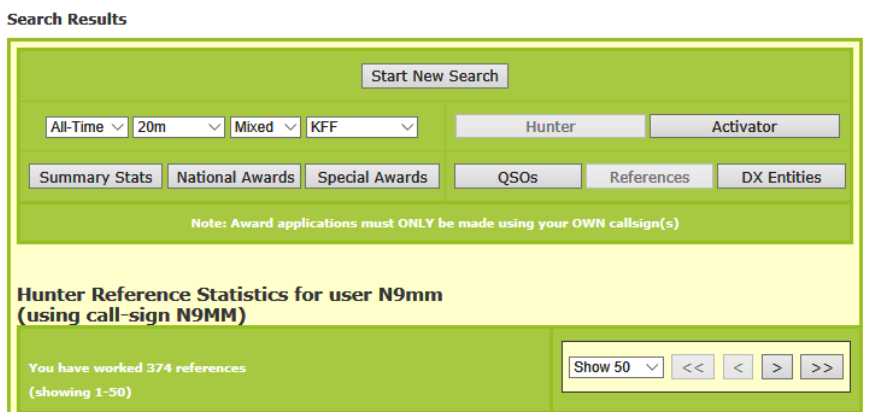

3. Next in the All Programs drop down, select KFF as shown below.



Logsearch will return the screen shown below. As can be seen in the bottom left-hand corner, N9MM has worked 374 KFF References on 20m.

- At this point, changing the Band drop down will provide the Logsearch results for the number of References on different bands. Again, in the bottom-left corner, N9MM has worked 85 KFF References on 30m.
